DIRECTIONS:

11. girls tennessee tumbler race
12. boys tennessee tumbler race (6 strokes, flip, etc.)
13. mom race (freestyle OR alt: don't mess up hair and makeup)
14. dad race (freestyle OR alt: dads "running" through the water)
15. innertube race (must remain sitting in innertube)
16. submarine race (under water as much as possible)
17. 8u seahorse relay
18. 9-14 seahorse relay (racing on noodles)
19. 10u girls best dive competition
20. 10u boys best dive competition
21. 18u girls best dive competition
22. 18u boys best dive competition
23. 19+ womens best dive competition

24. 19+ womens best dive competition (judged on height, splash, form, level of difficulty, and stage presence)
25. 6u girls 25 backstroke

27. screwdriver race (one freestyle stroke followed by one backstroke stroke, etc.)
28. kickboard race (kicking only)
29. 6u 100 freestyle relay (boys and girls mixed)
30. drag relay (swimmers must wear clothing over bathingsuits and pass the article of clothing on to teammates)
31. 10u dog paddle
32. 11+ dog paddle
33. tugboat race (in pairs: first swimmer pulls, second swimmer holds on to first swimmer's ankles and kicks)
34. feet first race (feet must always lead, must touch wall first)
35. friends and family relay A (at least 1 PBST swimmer and any 18u family members or friends in a freestyle relay)
36. friends and family relay B (2 PBST swimmers and 2 19+ family members or friends in a freestyle relay)
37. 10u boys vs. girls mixed medley relay
38. 12+ boys vs. girls mixed medley relay
39. coaches 100 freestyle exhibition
40. anything goes race (2 laps, no rules, just win!)
41. watermelon relay (pass the watermelon from person to person)
42. greasy watermelon (divide into two teams of about 4 or 5, cover a watermelon in crisco, drop it in the middle of the pool, and try to get the watermelon on your side of the pool deck to "score")
